- Have you thought of sharing your newsletter with the bishop, regional executive council, etc.? Yes. We have not shared it with the bishop, but we do now share it with our Family Councilor.
 - What Apostolic work does your fraternity do as a whole fraternity? What percentages of the fraternity participate?

Our main apostolic activity is a monthly sing-along at St. Teresa's Church Food Kitchen, which we call Fools For Francis. About 5 of our members, or 15%, participate each month. We collect food donations for the St. Vincent backpack program for school children. The fraternity contributes monthly to the Friars of the Renewal and the Amazon Relief Program. As a new apostolate, we support a family in India by quarterly donations through the Franciscan Family Apostolate.

• Does your fraternity attend Mass or prayer services outside the regular meeting times? No, although many members attend Mass together just before our monthly meeting. We did gather for Adoration with others in the parish once this year.
