The Fraternity has discussed the status of IL in regards to Servant Leadership, either monthly or bimonthly, at the Fraternity General Meetings in Ongoing Formation, during Council Meetings or at the IL Servant Leadership (SL) SJF Committee Meetings.NOTE: The 2024 St Joseph Fraternity Instrumentum Laboris topic that SJF will focus on to teach Fraternity Family members in "Ongoing Formation" in 2024 focuses on Franciscan Servant Leadership, especially built upon the information in the official OFS document entitled "Handbook for Franciscan Servant Leadership" Revised 2010. The St Joseph Fraternity Committee has been working over a year to design and print a Booklet titled "An Addendum to the OFS Franciscan Servant Leadership Handbook." This Booklet will be presented to the Fraternity at a special Seminar, probably lasting over several days, in early 2025.

• What initial goals has your fraternity set as a result of *Instrumentum Laboris (IL)*?

The 2024 Initial Goals of Instrumentum Laboris (IL) for SJF (St Joseph Fraternity) are:
To better implement into the spiritual life of the OFS Fraternity members, the OFS Servant
Leadership holy information and skills, found in the official OFS document "Handbook for Franciscan Servant Leadership" Revised 2010 available from Smokey Valley Printing.

- 1) <u>First Initial Goal:-</u> The Fraternity studied the official OFS Document "<u>Handbook for Fr Servant</u> <u>Leadership revised 2010</u>" during several Ongoing Formation teachings during our 2024 SJF monthly meetings. However, the Fraternity soon realized it would like to more deeply understand the Servant Leadership (SL) information contained within the original official OFS SL Handbook.
- 2) Second Initial Goal: So next, the SJF Council formed a committee to study the IL Topic of Servant Leadership more thoroughly. The IL SL SJF Committee consisted of mainly 3 persons: Fr Nicholas Mormando, OFM., Cap., Spiritual Asst; Jose Chaviano, OFS Formation Director; and Antoinette Toni Coffer, OFS. This Committee spent over a year reviewing the SL information located in official OFS document "Handbook for Fr Servant Leadership revised 2010" available from Smokey Valley Printing.
- 3) Third Initial Goal: After a thorough review of the "Handbook for Franciscan Servant Leadership Revised 2010" by the IL SJF SL Committee, the IL SJF SL Committee decided to formulate and write a new Booklet based on the OFS SL Handbook named the "Addendum to the Franciscan Servant Leadership Handbook. "The information contained in the new "Addendum to the Franciscan Servant Leadership Handbook" will be presented to St Joseph Fraternity Family Members at a special Seminar offered by the IL SJF SL Committee in early 2025.
- What goals has your fraternity reached as a result of *Instrumentum Laboris*?

The goals that the Fraternity has reached as a result of completing an Instrumentum Laboris regarding studying the official OFS SL document titled "Franciscan Servant Leadership Handbook revised 2010" are:

- 1) In 2024, the IL SL SJF Committee completed formulating and writing the "Addendum to the Franciscan Servant Leadership Handbook" Booklet. This Booklet is built upon the IL SL SJF Committee studying and contemplating on the official OFS document "Handbook for Franciscan Servant Leadership Revised 2010". The Booklet is designed by the following SJF SL Committee members: Fr Nicholas Mormando OFM Cap. Jose Chaviano OFS Masters of Theology, Antoinette Toni Coffer, OFS.
- 2) The IL SL Committee will present the newly inspired Booklet on the "Addendum to the Franciscan Servant Leadership Handbook", as well as, review the original official OFS document "The Handbook for Franciscan Servant Leadership Revised 2010 "at a special Seminar offered to St Joseph Fraternity Family members. This Seminar is scheduled to occur in early 2025 over 1 or 2 days, or longer if needed.

 - 2) Donation to "Love on the Street" a Catholic Charities associated charity organization-Goal: assist poor/homeless in Broward and Dade County, food, spiritual, clothing, toiletries-Blanket drive donations by Fraternity, and Nativity & St Boniface Catholic Church. given to Love on Streets to aid poor/homeless about 60 %
 - 3) Assist Schott Home for persons with disabilities Catholic community Goal: assist with fundraising, teach Catechism to members about 40%
 - 4) Bring plastic bags to General Meetings to aid food truck in Miami where Capuchin Friars volunteer about 70 %
 - 5) Donate socks, toiletries etc to homeless/needy in San Pedro area about 80 %

The Fraternity is focusing on holy growth in its authentic Franciscan spirituality and identity, in Christ, at this time per Father Nick Mormando,OFM.,Cap. Spiritual Asst for St Joseph Fraternity. Some of the various religious activities that various Fraternity members attend singularly or together with other Fraternity members, outside of regular gathering times are: attend daily Mass, Fraternity prays a Rosary once a week together on phone line, attend funeral for deceased member, Fraternity has Mass offered for various members as needed, ie., when ill; some members are Eucharistic Ministers to homebound Fraternity members; some members teach catechism or offer religious articles to homeless; some assist the parish priest with daily activities; two members have a family music ministry that provide music during Mass or other Catholic events; members of Women of Grace; attend Eucharistic Adoration; members of Magnificat; one member is taking advanced university courses in Franciscan Studies; attend retreats for entire Fraternity guided by Father Nicholas Mormando, OFM Cap., our Spiritual Assistant and Retreatmaster; attend San Pedro

Regional OFS Meeting in Orlando; pray with homeless as needed when volunteering at "Love on the Street" which is a JPIC apostolate to the homeless/needy; distribute donated religious articles, such as, rosaries, prayer cards, St Benedict medals, Miraculous Medals, Crucifixes to homeless, as needed when volunteering at "Love on the Street' - a JPIC apostolate for homeless/needy; attend OFS Profession of 5 new OFS FFMR St Joseph Fraternity members in 2024; two members prayed Liturgy of Hours over phone; some members attended Transitus of St Francis of Assisi; some members attend Bible study; some members have volunteered at Respect Life for years; Servant Leadership Committee from St Joseph Fraternity established in 2024, consisting of Fr Nicholas Mormando, OFM., Cap., Jose Chaviano, OFS – Formation Director and Masters in Theology special Franciscan Studies - Toni Coffer OFS met over a year in designing a new Booklet named "The Addendum to the Franciscan Servant Leadership Handbook Revised 2010."
